We have a work party scheduled for June 3 at 8:00 a.m. to lay the petro-mat in the new pit area and at the West end of the runway. If you can help for an hour or two, we should have the mat down and stapled in two hours. Free do-nuts and soda or coffee will be available. Our plan is to unpin the current tall safety fence at the East end of the pits, walk it out onto the runway, lay the petro-mat over the ground posts, cut holes for them to poke through and then walk the fence back and re-pin it. We will need about six people to make this move and since it is the first thing we need to do, if you can come at 8:00 a.m. we will get that out of the way. If you fly a BIG airplane or a scale Warbird, come and help make the field a better place to fly for your type of bird. I hope to see you there.






