TRCM Meeting Minutes, 1 May 2018 6:00 pm at Lodi Library

Call to order: 6:04

Announcements from the floor: Dick Wareham, of "Stinkin Badges" fame, not present. Visitors: John Casey

Officers Report:

President: Greg Hennefer, thanked the guys who policed up all the trash along the road to the west of the airfield. He was surprised at the amount of trash he carried home. Estimated to be about 100lbs. Greg reported that he was able to acquire the new sheet metal for the shade structure (with a few senior moments) i.e. forgot his ladders at the Sacramento store, where he picked up the sheet metal. The roofing crew, of Greg, Richard, Mike Dave, and Mitch installed the new metal and repaired the hole in the old part of the structure. Thanks guys.

Vice President: Mitch Biddle present, but nothing to add.
