Bob Keller won it on the second draw and gave it to Lucas.

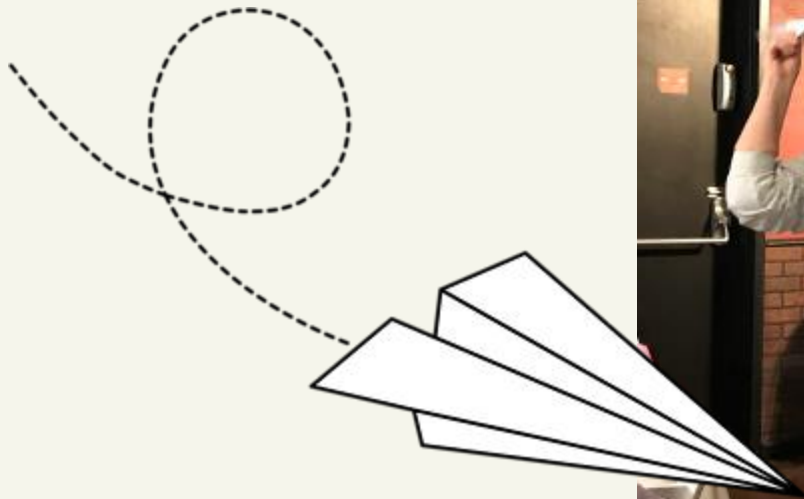
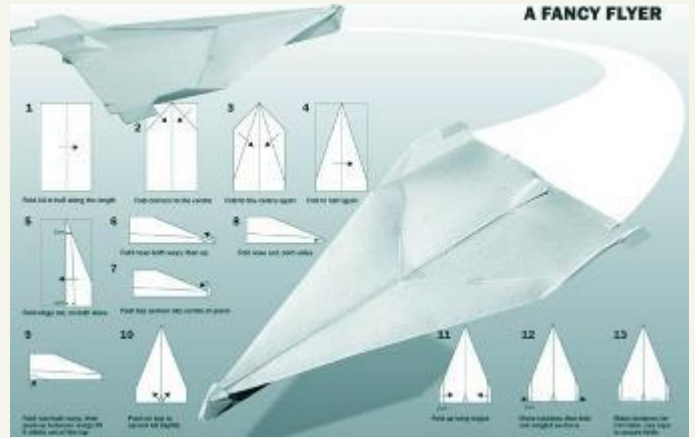

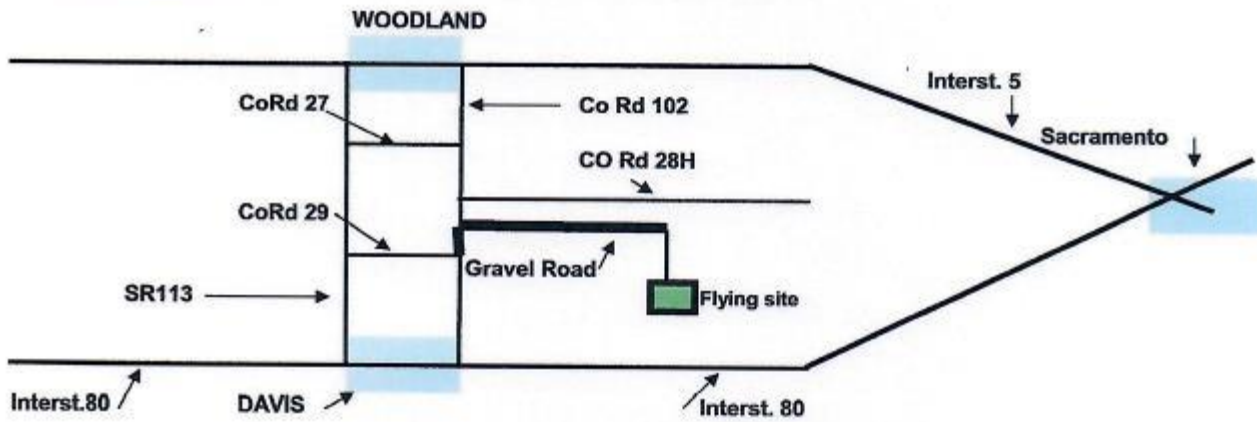
