VII. Show and Tell Neil G, brought in his "Cub" (I believe the designation is L-4) dressed up in Normandy Invasion markings complete with Olive Drab paint. Bulkhead connectors, Instrument panel, and other scale parts made by 3-D. Includes a self-starter. Radio, RTFG 56. Second Show and Tell, Don B. with his "Stuka" German WWII Dive Bomber, complete with siren, to scare people. Gator RC Kit, built by Wally F. DLE powered.

VIII. Awards:

Name that plane: Kangaroo Commonwealth CAC-CA 15 An Australian attempt at building a fighter aircraft. Looks similar to a P-51 Mustang. Was to be powered by the Wright 2800 Radial engine, but due to scarcity, ended up using a water cooled, in line Rolls Royce, turning a 4 bladed prop. Fuselage was 36.1 feet with a wingspan of 36 feet and a height of 14.1 feet. Empty wt was 7,500, max take off wt was 12,340 lbs. Max speed was 448 MPH with a range of 1,150 miles. Service Ceiling of 39,000 feet, Rate of climb 4,900 feet per second.

Although it never flew during WWII, it was proposed to be a Fighter/Interceptor with three 0.50 cal guns on each wing with 250 Rnds per gun. Wings were to receive five high explosive rockets each and hard points to carry up to two 1000 lb drop bombs.

After the meeting adjourned, it was time for the "Turkey Shoot", our annual event before Thanksgiving. The purpose is to break as many balloons (mounted on small sticks,

spaced evenly across the runway, usually 6). There are usually three heats of 3 minutes in length. Pilots are allotted points, 3 for a break and 1 for breaking a stick.

There were 8 pilots entered, with all makes of airplanes.

The event was very entertaining. The wind was pretty brisk, so there were crashes, flying over the pits and flying away, hitting the fence, hitting the runway.

Neil G. wiped out his nose gear, so took it off, then later decided to remove the main gear, so his plane was hand launched.

Mark H. had a small "foamy", not conducive to flying in wind. Anyway, he had a hard time as he approached the balloons. One time the wind took it and blew it over the pits and over the grape vines, and it wouldn't come back. I think he lost elevator or rudder control. The best he could do was, let it do what it wanted to do until it finally crashed into the vineyard. Plane was retrieved and after some pieces of tape, he was back at it again. He was doing pretty good when he finally collided with the safety fence, which ended his day.

Then, there is always Garret M., he has the balloon bust zeroed in. More than once, he wiped out all balloons in one heat and had to stop the time while the balloons were reset.

All in all, it was a lot of fun and the winners (6) took home a gift card for their turkey dinner. The winners were: Garrett M. 1st, with 42, 2nd, Neil G., with 14, 3rd, Jacob L with 12, 4th Mark H., with 11, 5th was Mervin O. with 9, and 6th was Don B., with 5. Randy L. gets a special mention, he got 1. Don L., could take some lessons from son, Jacob, as he ended up with 0. If I remember right, he wiped out his plane at the very beginning.


Dear TRCM members,




We will be taking nominations and voting at the December meeting. Please come to the meeting on the 12^{th} at 10:00 AM and help present this prestigious award.













